The use of the Landing for commercial use is not prohibited but is governed by a set of rules, permits and fees. The fees may be changed by resolution of the Town Board. Penalties may also be determined by resolution of the town board.

The rules for commercial use, not listed in entirety, include but are not limited to: (see Code Enforcement office for complete rules.

1. Commercial users are defined as Contractors doing construction both on land and/or in the water on Skaneateles Lake and its water shed.
2. Those Contractors that want to use the Borodino Landing to load or unload Barges or similar craft with materials **may do so only after contacting the Spafford Codes Enforcement officer and obtaining the proper permits and paying the proper fees per project.**
3. Use of the landing is subject to the following restrictions:
  - o Activity shall be limited to loading and/or unloading of material onto the barges or similar craft.
  - o No cutting of lumber, mixing of concrete, or any preparation work of any kind is allowed at the landing.
  - o No loading at the landing to interfere with swimmers or fishermen.
4. No trucks or vehicles are allowed on the landing except during loading and unloading. No trucks or vehicles are to be left at the landing unattended for any length of time.
