Financial Assistance For Lead Risk Reduction Work

You may be eligible for up to \$20,000 of assistance to remove lead from your property if:

- 1. You own or rent property built before 1978 and
- 2. Your family or the family living in the rental property meets the income guidelines AND
- 3. You have a child age six or younger who lives at or visits the property often.
